SECTION A – GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES

The Florida Association of Realtors Education Foundation, Inc., is a Florida not for profit corporation. Its purpose is to provide real estate related educational scholarships and grants. The Student Scholarship Program is available to the following types of applicants:

- a) Florida High School seniors who will be attending an undergraduate College or University,
- b) Students currently enrolled in an undergraduate College or University, and
- c) Students pursuing graduate studies.

Those students considering a career in Real Estate or allied fields, including, but not limited to, Real Estate Brokerage, Real Estate Finance, Real Estate Management, Real Estate Development, Real Estate Appraisal, Real Estate Planning, and Real Estate Law, will be given special consideration in accordance with the purposes of the FAR Education Foundation. Candidates should be either currently enrolled in such a program or document their intent to enroll in such a program within one year of the application deadline.

There will be no limitations as to location of the College or University attended provided the applicant indicates their intent to return to work in Florida after graduation. Proof of the applicant's legal Florida residency is required. A post office box is not considered proof of residency. Only U.S. citizens and permanent residents are eligible. Academic achievements, financial need, relationship to the Realtor family, sincerity of purpose in real estate and allied endeavors, contributions to family, school, and community, will be considered in the selection process. All decisions as to whether or not an applicant qualifies will be at the sole and absolute discretion of the Foundation's Board of Directors.

Scholarships are up to \$2,000 to students attending a two year College, and \$4,000 to students attending a four year College or University. An applicant is eligible to receive one scholarship award per 12 month period, up to a maximum of two scholarships. The scholarship will be sent directly to the College or University which must be accredited by the appropriate accrediting bodies. The number of scholarships awarded will be at the discretion of the Board of Directors based on their review of funding levels.

Application Procedure:

Applications should be submitted to FAR Education Foundation, Inc., *c/o Janet Valentine, P.O. Box 725025, Orlando, FL 32872-5025*. Insert complete application in large envelope without folding. Faxes and emails will not be considered. The application deadline for the current program year is

March 15. The recipients will be announced following the spring meeting of the Board of Directors.

A complete application must include the following items:

1. Student Scholarship Application Form completed and signed by the applicant.
2. At least two reference letters.
3. Letter/statement from the school confirming acceptance and/or enrollment.
4. A copy of applicant's academic transcripts for the immediate prior 3-year period.
5. Proof of legal Florida residency (e.g., Florida Driver License or state issued I.D. card)
